Remembering The Reformation

Jon Hus (1372 AD – 1415 AD) was a Czeck reformer that influenced Martin Luther. Hus preached that the head of the church was Jesus Christ and not the Pope. He was one of the first reformers to condemn indulgences and would advocate authority rests in church councils and not clergy. For his doctrines Hus was burned at the stake. Hus in Czeck means goose. Martin Luther would often refer to Jon Hus death as “the goose is cooked.”
